Addictive diseases belong to the group of the most frequent diseases nowadays. Drug and tobacco abuse, particularly combined use of more than one substance, represent an increasing problem, especially among the young population. The so-called synthetic drugs, artificially manufactured substances with



pharmacological properties which are causing specific effects similar to natural drugs are increasingly used. Addictive diseases directly or indirectly affect all phases of a life cycle of individuals and their families, preventing their functioning in the spheres of personal, family, professional and social life. Society as a whole suffers numerous consequences due to the substance abuse or dependence.

Program of the School

Program of the School includes the following main topics:

(I) Basic characteristics (historical, biological, psychological) of the concept of addictive diseases and other mental problems

(II) Ethical, professional and social significance of implementation of non-institutional procedures in the approach to patients with addictions

(III) Models of sensitization and training of health professionals, related professions and general population from the static to the dynamic concept of addictive disease treatment
